Instruction, danger and warning signs


Truck entrance Hafenstraße



Press the lit button to request an ID card.



- Remove the ID card and hold it in front of the reader next to the lit button.
- At green traffic light and opened barrier, you can drive to the factory terrain.



 Important! Make sure that your ID card is unlocked at the loading point for the exit. An exit without activation is not possible!



- At the exit, enter the ID card into the exit terminal.
- With green traffic light and opened barrier, you can leave the factory terrain.

Safety advice for truck drivers

- Road traffic on these premises is subject to German traffic regulations (StVO).
- · Rail traffic has right of way.
- Do not stop on railways crossing! Keep a minimum distance of 1,75 m to rail tracks.
- Reversing lorries must be guided by an assisting person.
- Drivers and passengers must not remain in vehicle during loading/unloading. The specifiec protective clothing must be worn.

Other instructions

- Visitors have to sign in by the security staff at the front gate. Keep of the production-hall. A host will take care of you and show you the factory.
- Plant Security must be informed of traffic accidents or other damage (phone: +49 2381 420-652). Fire, other accidents and necessary assistance call the emergency number +49 2381 420-112.
- In an event of a fire, a siren will sound, go immediately to a designated assembly point and wait for further instructions.
- The personal data of the visitors are stored for a maximum of one year. (Note on data protection). If the visitor card is lost or irreparably damaged, Mannesmann Precision Tubes GmbH reserves the right to charge a fee of 50 EUR.
- They will receive a visitor card from the gatekeeper to enter the factory area. The visitor card must be worn visibly at all times. At the end of the visit, the visitor's card is withdrawn at the exits of the Kissinger Weg gate.

Use serviceable footware only!

Use handdrails when going up or down stairs.

Photographing or filming are not permitted.

Please secure your tie or scarf.

Persons wearing pacemakers can not come on the tour.
